Euro 2008 Odds: Poland vs Croatia Group B, is scheduled for Monday June 16th, 2008 beginning at 2:30 pm EST from Wörthersee Stadion, in Klagenfurt, Austria, on ESPN-Classic. Group B leading Croatia (2-0-0; 3 points; Diff. 2), will try to stay undefeated in Monday's fixture against last place Poland (0-1-1; 1 point; Diff. -2). BodogLife.com has Poland -150 Euro 2008 Odds favorite against Croatia (+120). Croatia has looked very impressive thus far in this Euro 2008 Cup. They basically put a strangle-hold on Group B by beating two very tough teams in Austria and Germany in their first two matches.

Croatian coach, Slaven Bilic, is ready to make substitutions in his side's final Group B match against Poland.

It is very likely that, start Dario Simic and Ivan Klasnic will start Monday against Poland. The odds of a DRAW in this Euro 2008 Odds: Poland vs Croatia Group B are +260.

Also for the Croatian side, Luka Modric, Darijo Srna, Josip Simunic, Robert Kovac, Ivica Olic and Mladen Petric, whom have all received one yellow card and could be rested to avoid any inconveniences for the quarterfinals. But Bilic isn't the only one planning to make changes in his line up come Monday's match. Leo Beenhakker, the Poland coach, also says he might juggle his starting line up, as they desperately need this win.
