Arizona Cardinals vs Carolina Panthers NFL Picks: The Cardinals are (4-2) off their bye week and their most recent win was a big one beating the Dallas Cowboys at home, 30-24. Sean Morey blocked Mat McBriar's punt, then Monty Beisel scooped up the ball and scored from 3 yards to give the Cardinals a wild victory in overtime. The Cardinals' home winning streak is their longest since 1975-76. This week they'll try to win on the road. "It didn't seem like the bounces or the calls were going our way and sometimes you have to overcome those things," said Cardinals coach Ken Whisenhunt, whose team is 9-2 at home since he became coach. The Panthers are (5-2) after beating New Orleans 30-7 last week. QB Jake Delhomme was 14/22 for 195 yards and 2 TD's. Jonathan Stewart rushed for another score and the Panthers' defense shut down Drew Brees and the NFL's second-rated offense. Carolina twice stopped New Orleans on fourth down in the second half. Steve Smith caught 6 balls for 122 yards and 1 TD. They have the 3rd best defense in the league for points allowed (14.9), 5th in total yards allowed (275.7) and 2nd in the league in pass yards allowed (168.7) after shutting down NO high-octane attack under 30 points for the first time this season.
