## Kassim Ouma vs Cornelius Bundrage Betting Preview

Kassim Ouma vs Cornelius Bundrage 10-round bout between two top-15 Jr. Middleweights at the crossroads will be a turning point for the winner on Friday night. Ouma, 25-4-1 (15), gave former Middleweight champion Jermain Taylor all he could handle in their December 2006 title fight, but has not looked like the same fighter since that brutal fight. Kassim Ouma is a -600 boxing betting odds favorite in Kassim Ouma vs Cornelius Bundrage.

Bundrage a.k.a. "K-9" was the mega-popular "Contender" TV show star that has shown himself to be more personality than legitimate prizefighter. The 29-year old Ouma is a relentless southpaw pressure fighter that when is in a groove, can be one tough cookie to chew on. Bundrage is a stocky, one-dimensional boxer/puncher that has a good right hand and little else. Kassim Ouma vs Cornelius Bundrage TOTAL ROUNDS Boxing betting is at 9.5 rounds.

Bundrage, 27-3 (16), was most recently outclassed by rising prospect Joel Julio in July of 2007 before being KO'd badly in the 8th round. Both of these fighters do have heart, but Ouma, has the better chin and more all-around boxing skill. Kassim lives in the South Florida area and has been known to down his share of Budweiser, but if he comes into this fight in-shape, he will dominate Bundrage.
