The Miners' ongoing win streak, which dates back to two months, helped them clinch the Conference USA regular season title.

"We've won a bunch like this down the stretch," said conference USA coach of the year Tony Barbee. "We need games like this to challenge us going into the C-USA Tournament."

This quarterfinal matchup is set to tip off at 10 PM ET (7 PM PT) live from the Bank of Oklahoma Center in Tulsa, OK.
